Project Scope

Project is to install detectable warning tile (DWT) at grade crossings throughout the RT LRT System to increase safety.

Project History

- There was a class action law suit in 2003 that initiated this project to improve ADA compliance on existing facilities. RT agreed to add detectable warning tiles at grade crossings.
- The entire Light Rail System was evaluated and grade crossings were prioritize based on available funding.
- Phase I and Phase II are complete (Downtown Sacramento).
- Phase III Folsom Corridor DWT design review completed by the County of Sacramento, City of Rancho Cordova, and City of Folsom.

Project Status / Planned Work

- Notice to Proceed was issued 04/13/17. Phase III includes DWT at 13 grade crossings along the Folsom corridor. This work is proposed to be complete by 08/31/17.
- Additional work will be planned based on available budget / priority.
