



Conceptual Plan for Pocket/Land Park/ Meadowview and Surrounding Communities

Community Based Bus

Six additional community bus routes will be added to the existing system to serve key destinations. Frequencies of all community bus routes will be no more than 30 minutes and service hours will be expanded.

Hi-Bus Routes

Three brand new Hi-Bus routes will serve this community with higher quality and higher capacity buses and frequencies of 5-30 minutes. The routes will conceptually be aligned as follows:

- Florin Rd. from Kennedy High School in the Pocket area to Bradshaw Rd., making connections with the existing light rail and Burbank High School
- Riverside Blvd. from Kennedy High School on Florin Rd. to the Central City with connections to light rail, street tram, buses and major employers
- Freeport Blvd. from Meadowview Rd. to the Central City with connections to light rail, street tram and buses, as well as connecting to Sacramento Executive Airport, Sacramento City College and major employers

Light Rail

The proposed expansion to Elk Grove will extend to Kammerer Rd. just west of Highway 99 and will have frequencies of 5-30 minutes. It is proposed to serve Cosumnes River College in addition to shopping and medical facilities along Bruceville Rd. and Big Horn Blvd.
